CLASS C CLASSIFICATION PUBLIC HEARING

The Clayton County Board of Supervisors will conduct a public hearing on the following proposed Class C Classification at **10:30 am, on Monday, February 26, 2018** in their office at 600 Gunder RD, Elkader, Iowa. Notice is in accordance with Iowa Code Chapter 331.305. Members of the public are encouraged to make oral or written statements regarding the proposed Class C classification.

That a portion of "318th Street", originally established September 7, 1888 (See Road Record Volume 3, page 543) lying in Sections 20 and 21 of T92N, R3W of Clayton County, Iowa. The intention of this reclassification is to change the segment of public road commencing at the West Quarter Section Line of the Northwest of the Southeast of Section 21 along 318th Street and continuing westerly to the current point of termination to Class C classification.
