Meeting of the Clayton County Board of Supervisors at their office, 600 Gunder Road, Elkader, Iowa.

Keehner moved, Doeppke seconded to approve the minutes of the April 23, 2019, meeting. Ayes: Doeppke, Keehner, Peterson. Motion carried.

Doeppke moved, Keehner seconded to approve claims as presented. Ayes: Doeppke, Keehner, Peterson. Motion carried.

The Board worked on the FY2019 County Budget Amendment.

Elkader Mayor Josh Pope presented the Board with a proposal to procure Lover's Leap and Sand Pit Road. The City would like to develop the area into a tourist attraction. Comments were heard regarding proposed development plans, road maintenance, easements, canoe landing access, park management, and effects on neighboring businesses (Abu Nawas Beverage Company & Bruening Rock Products). The Board will visit the site on May 7, 2019.

There was discussion regarding quarry scale certification by the State of Iowa specifically addressing concrete approaches, measuring by cubic yard versus tons, volumetric scanning (LiDAR), weights and measures 2 year replacement, and rock program specifications. Peterson moved, Doeppke seconded to keep the measurements for use in the rock program the same for this year and to grant quarries one year to implement scales that can be certified by the State of Iowa.
