Treasurer Linda Zuercher presented an abatement of taxes, for a parcel owned by the Luana Fire Department, due to mix-up with the tax exemption certificate filing. Zuercher had spoken previously with Dale Crozier, of MFL MarMac School District, concerning the tax abatement as most taxes would be allocated to the school. Crozier approved the abatement as it is for community betterment. McCartney moved to abate the taxes for payment in September and March in fiscal year 2019 in the amount of \$470 for parcel 32-08-288-007 due to a clerical error during the real estate transaction.
